

Disciplinary Measures

For simple disturbances and infractions of regulations like coming late or wearing improper uniform students will be disciplined by losing playtime privileges, doing extra class work, and other like similar punishments.

However, some behaviors are serious and demand a more serious approach. For behaviors like fighting, cheating, stealing, lying, constant classroom disturbance and similar behaviors, the following system will be applied. Students who are continually disruptive throughout the school year will not be admitted to GSS for the next school year.

Prior to beginning this process, basic behavior management techniques are applied by the school.

Step 1: Parents are called for a conference. The student's parents must come or he or she will not be allowed to enter the class. In the conference, the parents will sign a document agreeing that they will follow the child carefully and implement punishment at home.

Step 2: The student's parents are called for a second conference after all the student's teachers have been consulted. In this conference, the parents will sign a document agreeing that they will follow the child carefully and implement punishment at home. The student will be suspended from attending school for one week. A zero percent will be given for all academic work missed during the suspension.

Step 3: The student will be expelled from the school. Once expelled, a student cannot return to the Gibson School Systems.
